## NOTES FOR AUTHORS

---

**Scope.** *The Globe*, journal of The Australian Map Circle Inc. (AMC), publishes articles, news items and reviews on map librarianship and accessing mapping information, map makers and map production, carto-bibliography, the history of map making, historical geography and exploration where this reflects the history of efforts to map the landscape and other topics of interest to members. Particular emphasis is given to Australia. *The Globe* gives priority to publishing papers presented at the annual conference of the Australian Map Circle; conference papers that are otherwise marginal to the scope of the journal may be published.

The AMC invites authors to submit, for publication in *The Globe*, articles, news items, and reviews on topics of interest to members. The desired length of articles is between 1500 and 4000 words. News items and book reviews should be no longer than 1500 words.

**Peer-review.** All papers submitted for publication in *The Globe* are peer-reviewed. Authors may advise the Editors in confidence of persons whom they would prefer not to review their paper. *The Globe* also publishes as 'Reports' articles with content not requiring peer-review. The Editors make the final decision on what articles are published.

**Format.** All contributions should be submitted in electronic form, preferably sent via email, or posted on disk (MS Windows format), unless cleared otherwise with the Editors. The electronic copy should be saved in MS Word format; other formats should be checked with the Editors.

**Style.** Contributions should be clearly written in non-specialist language, with spelling following the *Macquarie Dictionary*. Papers should be accompanied by an abstract where appropriate. Punctuation, stylistic rules and printing conventions followed are those recommended by the *Australian Government Style Manual*. Titles, headings and sub-headings should be clearly indicated. Sub-titles in the main title of the paper are not preferred. References should take the form of endnotes or in-text (Harvard); footnotes are not supported. Bibliographic references should be as described in the *Australian Government Style Manual*.

**Author Bio.** Contributions must be accompanied by author contact details: postal and email address and phone number. Authors are also requested to supply their name, position/occupation/relevant affiliation and contact details they wish placed at the bottom of the first page of their article.

**Illustrations.** Photographs, maps, drawings, tables and other illustrations should be in electronic format, preferably in the same document as the article, or if separate, in JPG or TIF format. They must be clearly labelled, with captions, and be of a standard suitable for reproduction. Where permission to publish an illustration is required, for example from a library, it is the

responsibility of the author to obtain the relevant permission. All illustrations should be prepared in accordance with the one or two column layout dimensions used in recent issues of *The Globe*.

**Colour.** The Australian Map Circle will cover the cost of up to a maximum of two pages of colour illustrations in each issue of *The Globe*. Colour illustrations may be included where, in the opinion of the Editors, they add substantially to the impact of the article. Authors may cover the cost of any additional or alternative colour illustrations they would like to include in their article. Each colour page costs approximately \$200 per print run.

**Offprints.** Authors of articles published in *The Globe* will be supplied with an electronic copy of their article in PDF format, and also a printed copy of that issue if they are not a member of the AMC (all members of course receive a copy as part of their membership). 'Offprints' of articles published in *The Globe* are not automatically supplied to authors; if an author requests the supply of offprints within one year of the publication of their article, the Editors will supply two offprints to the author.

**Publication Rights.** By submitting any work to be considered for publication in *The Globe*, you agree to the following conditions:

1. The author of any work submitted for publication in *The Globe* (the Author) grants to the Australian Map Circle (the Publisher) a non-exclusive licence to publish, reproduce and communicate any article submitted for publication in *The Globe* in printed volume form and in other media including digital and electronic form.
2. The Author grants to the Publisher a non-exclusive licence to sublicense third parties (including collecting societies) to exercise all or any of the rights granted by clause 1.
3. Where the Publisher has exercised its rights under clause 2, the first \$100.00 of the revenues received in each calendar year under any sub-licence will go to the Publisher; revenues beyond this amount in each calendar year will be shared in the proportion 50% to the Author and 50% to the Publisher.
