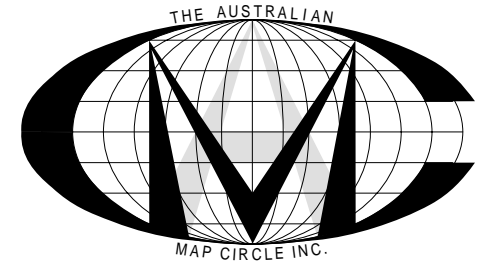

Objectives

The Australian Map Circle Inc. (AMC) is a national group of map producers, users and curators, which acts as a medium of communication for all those interested in maps. The AMC was founded in 1973 with the following aims:

- To promote communication between producers, users and curators of maps.
- To improve the skills and status of persons working in map collections.
- To promote the development and effective exploitation of map collections in Australia.

It has grown in size and scope, with members in every state as well as overseas. An active local branch exists in Victoria, and similar branches are being established in other states. The function of the branch is to act as a channel of communication for local members.

The AMC maintains close links with similar bodies in New Zealand, North America and Europe. The AMC is the Australian National Member of the Geography and Map Libraries Section of IFLA.

The AMC Conference is held each year, generally in a different city. All aspects of map use and mapping are discussed and the proceedings of the conference are published as part of the journal of the AMC, *The Globe*.

Membership

Membership of the AMC is from the 1st of January of each year; those joining during the year will receive any previous publications for that year. Subscriptions fall due on the 1st of January, and must be paid by the 31st of March of that year, after which date unpaid membership will lapse.

Subscribers are entitled to receive the AMC journal *The Globe* and the year's series of occasional *Newsletters*.
